### Objective

To provide youth with innovation and technology training, and access to collaboration spaces, specialized curricula, mentorship and economic incentives, to promote STEM education and entrepreneurship.

#### Effect

The creation of low-cost, high-impact, high-quality innovation solutions that generate affordable access and livelihood opportunities for their communities on a long term, sustainable basis.

The Trust for the Americas has partnered with NCB Foundation and Mico University College, an educational institution with vast experience in the forefront of Jamaica's efforts to improve access to quality educational opportunities, to design and implement the first year of the Project. To maximize the effect and to have a longlasting impact, the Project is designed for a 3-year implementation strategy.

Target: At-risk youth (16 to 30-years-old) dealing with complex social environments, youth crime, poor academic performance, and living in vulnerable communities.

#### Main components:

- Customized innovation-centered curricula
- Access to state-of-the-art technologies
- Mentorship
- Collaborative atmosphere
- Economic incentives
